Although approximately 130 Clifton Park residents have submitted a Motion to Have the Current Clifton Park Trustees Removed, it should be understood that that number represents less than one-half of the sublots in Clifton Park. There are approximately 206 sublots in Clifton Park. The 130 residents are owners of about 80 lots, so the majority of the sublot owners have not joined the Secondary Parties' Motion.

The Trustees, accordingly, rely on their Brief in Opposition to the Motion to Remove for their response to the Secondary Parties' Motion.
