

TO CLIFTON PARK JUNE 1.

Senator Hanna Tells Realty Company's Stockholders That Cars Will be Running—To Build Inn.

The annual meeting of the Clifton Park Land & Improvement Co. was held yesterday afternoon in the office of the company in the Cuyahoga building. Nearly all of the stock was represented at the meeting and the greatest enthusiasm was manifested over the outlook for the coming year for the company's property.

The completion of the new boulevard and the railway tracks thereon to Clifton park, as well as the improvement of Lake avenue direct to the property, was a matter of congratulation. It is now an assured fact that street cars will be running to Clifton park early in the summer, and Lake avenue, having already been opened clear through, will make one of the finest speedways in the city.

A letter from Senator Hanna, president of the Little Consolidated Railway Co., was read, stating that express trains and regular five-minute cars would be running to Clifton park by June 1.

The board of directors decided to immediately begin the erection of a handsome inn on the lake shore in the center of Clifton park, which will be opened early in the season to the stockholders and their friends. All other improvements, such as gas, water, electric lights, telephone service and magnificent roadways are already completed, and a number of beautiful homes are under way for completion by the opening of the warm weather.
