

significant increase. Please remember that the Trustees can impose reasonable restrictions as needed on all Beach users, not just the Clifton Club. What has changed dramatically is we have a more attractive, wide sandy beach and more people find it an appealing place to spend time.

6. The published request for decades of Trust records is an unnecessary diversion. The Trust records contain years of financial, personnel and personal information, letters to neighbors for stepping over the accepted conduct line and other matters not pertinent to this discussion.

7. The Trustees retained well-respected legal counsel to ensure that we have and will continue to appropriately carry out our fiduciary responsibilities. By law, that legal counsel is the Trustees' counsel, not the beneficiaries' counsel. In order to maintain the integrity of that relationship, communications with counsel will remain privileged.

We were looking forward to the open meeting this week at the Lakewood Women's Pavilion. All the Trustees planned to participate. However, we have been informed by Arthur Dueck that under the current circumstances 'we cannot allow the Trustees to attend'.
